GHCA Boat Ramp Rules

Access the 2 GHCA-owned boat ramps (comes with your GHCA Membership) by calling a Volunteer. Current Members can also lease a key for your convenience.

Requirements to lease a 2024 GHCA Boat Ramp Key

- 1. Proof of ownership in Gulf Harbors or long-term rental (must show a lease with 6 months+ remaining on it from the date you apply to lease the key.)
- 2. A current 2024 GHCA membership.
- 3. A current picture ID (driver's license, passport, government issued ID, or military ID)
- 4. You must be 21 years of age or older.
- A completed and signed Boat Ramp Key Holder Acceptance of Rules and Regulations and the Release and Waiver of Liability form.
- The return of your leased 2023 GHCA Boat Ramp Key, if applicable (failure to return last year's key may result in a \$100 fine plus the security deposit and lease fee for the current year).
- 7. Contractors must supply a Certificate of Insurance and business license.
- 8. The corresponding fee(s) paid (see below).

2024 FEES

1. Security Deposit: \$10.00. This is applicable to all GHCA Boat Ramp Key applicants.

Upon return of your previously leased GHCA Boat Ramp Key, the prior year's security deposit will be used towards the security deposit for the current year's GHCA Boat Ramp Key lease.

A. Homeowner/Long Term Renter: \$ 40.00 B. Homeowner Contractor: \$500.00

C. Homeowner Advertising on

D. Outside Contractor: \$750.00

Proper Pet Waste Disposal

Pasco County is asking pet owners to do their part by collecting their pet's waste and properly disposing of it.

When pet waste is left on the ground, stormwater runoff carries the bacteria and nutrients into waterways. This waste runoff contributes to algae blooms and unhealthy conditions for fish and wildlife. Polluted waters are also unsafe for swimming and recreation.

Keep Pasco County's waterways clean by disposing of your pet waste in the trash. Violations can result in a \$150 fine.

From the Desk of Public Relations

Since we started employing extra patrols from the Sheriff's department to monitor

traffic, I hope you are noticing some improvement. The goal is not to try to trap drivers, but rather to raise awareness and help curb some of the more dangerous activity. To that end, the deputies have issued many warnings, and when warranted, citations have been written. This program is continuing at random dates and times, so be careful out there.

Previously I mentioned that Pasco County is starting to deal with collapsed storm drains that cross private property to drain into the canals. A lot of you have called the county directly to report broken storm drains, and I have been asked to set the proper expectations. Where a storm drain pipe has broken, the county will enter into an easement agreement with the property owner to allow them to access the pipe and make repairs. However, there are instances where the problem is with the owner's seawall. A seawall can settle or pull away, and this shift will cause

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the storm drain pipe to pull away and break. In these cases, it is the owner's responsibility to make sure the seawall is properly repaired before the county can fix the pipe. The county will not repair your seawall. When the seawall is repaired, the pipe should be reinstalled in the seawall, and then the county can repair any broken sections or reline the pipe. If your seawall is fine, the county can make the repairs and fill in any depressed or washed out areas caused by the broken pipe. If you want to report a broken storm drain pipe, you can email me and I will submit it.

And if you are making modifications to the outside of your home, or building a new home, and even if you have already obtained the required permits, please be aware that the plans still need to be submitted to the Architectural Committee to check for compliance with deed restrictions. The county permit even states that the homeowner is responsible for complying with any deed restrictions. 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

Peanut Butter Pretzel Banana Delight

Ingredients:

- 4 cups of Peanut Butter Filled Pretzels, crushed
- 8 Tablespoons (1 stick) of Unsalted Sweet Cream Butter Sticks
- ½ cup, + 2/3 cup of Light Brown Sugar
- 16 ounces of Cream Cheese, softened

- 1 ½ cups of Heavy Whipping Cream
- 1 Tablespoon of Pure Vanilla Extract
- 4 Bananas, sliced
- 1 cup of Original Dairy Whipped Topping

Directions:

- 1. In a skillet over medium-high heat, melt butter and ½ cup of brown sugar in a pan until well incorporated. Stir in crushed pretzels and continue cooking for 2 minutes. Remove from heat and let cool while making the filling.
- 2. In a large bowl, add cream cheese, whipping cream, the remaining 2/3 cup of brown sugar, and the vanilla. Using a wire whisk or a hand blender, whip mixture until well combined, about 2 minutes. Continue beating until very smooth and creamy with a pudding-like consistency, about an additional 2-3 minutes. This will yield 5 cups of filling after whipping.
- 3. To assemble, spread $\frac{1}{2}$ of the pretzel layer in the bottom of a 9 x 13 dish, followed by 2 cups of the Vanilla Filling. Top with $\frac{1}{2}$ of the sliced bananas. Repeat the layers. Finish by adding the last cup of Vanilla Filling and smoothing over the bananas.
- 4. To serve, place a portion of the pudding in a bowl and serve with a squirt of whipped topping!

NOTE: If desired, this recipe can be served in 10 parfait glasses as individual servings.

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
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

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
